



GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN ACUPUNCTURE

Overview

This is a two-year part-time training program specially designed for western medical trained doctors and dentists. Candidates could expect to learn the fundamental TCM theories, TCM diagnostics, knowledge and techniques of acupuncture and moxibustion, and clinical practice. Upon completion of the course, candidates are required to sit for the college graduation examination. Candidates who pass the college graduation examination would then be eligible to register for the Singapore Acupuncturists Registration Examination (SARE) conducted by TCM Practitioners Board.

Eligibility

Applicant must be a local registered Medical Doctor or Dentist with the Singapore Medical Council and Singapore Dental Council respectively.

Course Structure

The course structure is as shown in the table below. The modes of training include classroom teaching and clinical practice. Total course-hour is 405 course hours, in which 305 course hours are classroom teaching and 100 course hours are clinical practice. It is a 2-year part-time course.

- Medical Doctor or Dentist who possesses a medical or dental degree with a minimum postgraduate experience of 2 years.
- Applicant must be currently registered (fully or conditional) with Singapore Medical Council or Singapore Dental Council.
